

Pollutant Exhaust: Approaching the Zero Emission Zone

Cars



- 1 car in the 1970s produced as many pollutant elements as 100 cars today.
- Particulate matter filters can reduce particulate emissions from diesel vehicles by over 99%.

Trucks



- Compared to 1992 standards, Euro VI emission levels will reduce nitrogen oxides (NOx) and particulate matter (PM) emissions by 95% and 97% respectively.
- \bullet Particulate matter emissions from all trucks on the road are 40% lower than a decade ago even though they drive 40% more kilometres today.
- AdBlue technology reduces nitrogen oxides (NOx) emissions even further, while cleaner diesel reduces sulphur emissions.
